Wailuku, HI (December 7, 2018) — Maui AIDS Foundation will host Mardi Gras Maui on Saturday, February 23, 2019 at the Waikapu Ballroom of the King Kamehameha Golf Club in Wailuku at 5:30pm. The event benefits Maui AIDS Foundation, which provides services for individuals living with HIV/AIDS, along with outreach, screening, testing and education for local communities at risk for HIV and other sexually transmitted infections.
